Accompanying Documents

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1. Overview of Operating Results, Etc.

(1) Overview of results of operations

During the six months under review, although some movement was observed in China and other markets, the overall sense of uncertainty could not be denied. In this situation, the Group steadily promoted its business in each of its locations, and as a result, revenue stood at ¥60,054 million (up 20.6% year on year), operating profit was ¥15,208 million (up 53.4% year on year), and profit attributable to owners of parent was ¥7,145 million (up 48.4% year on year), with both revenue and profit reaching historically high levels.

Segment results are as follows:

- a. In Japan, revenue decreased 14.6% year on year, to ¥13,039 million, and segment profit grew 457.5% year on year, to ¥632 million.
- b. In China, revenue increased 20.8% year on year, to ¥51,044 million, and segment profit grew 43.6% year on year, to ¥13,844 million.
- c. In India, revenue increased 19.4% year on year, to \(\frac{4}{2}\),609 million, and segment profit came to \(\frac{4}{2}\) million, compared to segment loss of \(\frac{4}{127}\) million in the same period of the previous fiscal year.
- d. In South Korea, revenue decreased 24.8% year on year, to ¥658 million, and segment profit decreased 52.8% year on year, to ¥23 million.
- e. In other markets, revenue increased 264.5% year on year, to ¥652 million, and segment profit amounted to ¥39 million, compared to a segment loss of ¥74 million in the same period of the previous fiscal year.

Segment profit is calculated by deducting cost of sales and selling, general and administrative expenses from revenue.

(2) Overview of financial position

(i) State of assets, liabilities and net assets

Assets totaled ¥130,122 million at the end of the six months under review, increasing ¥2,815 million from the end of the previous fiscal year.

The result was mainly due to increases of ¥3,866 million in cash and cash equivalents, ¥263 million in right-of-use assets, and ¥530 million in other financial assets, despite decreases of ¥1,315 million in trade and other receivables and ¥749 million in other current assets.

Liabilities totaled ¥39,397 million at the end of the six months under review, decreasing ¥3,794 million from the end of the previous fiscal year.

The result was mainly due to an increase of ¥610 million in deferred tax liabilities, despite decreases of ¥1,767 million in trade and other payables, ¥631 million in income taxes payable, etc., and ¥1,889 million in contract liabilities.

Equity totaled ¥90,724 million at the end of the six months under review, increasing ¥6,609 million from the end of the previous fiscal year.

The result was mainly due to the recording of \$10,740 million in profit and \$1,608 million in other comprehensive income, despite decreases of \$1,019 million in purchase of treasury shares, \$2,671 million in dividends, and \$2,119 million in non-controlling interest resulting from capital transactions.

(ii) State of cash flows during the six months under review

Cash and cash equivalents at the end of the six months under review increased ¥3,866 million from the end of the previous fiscal year, to ¥31,596 million.

(Cash flows from operating activities)

Net cash provided by operating activities was ¥11,282 million (cash generated of ¥1,808 million in the same period of the previous fiscal year).

The result principally reflected an increase in cash attributable to profit before tax of \$14,935 million, depreciation and amortization of \$1,201 million, and a decrease in trade and other receivables of \$2,546 million, which was partly offset by a decrease in trade and other payables of \$1,865 million, a decrease in contract liabilities of \$1,852 million, and income taxes paid of \$4,786 million.

(Cash flows from investing activities)

Net cash used in investing activities was ¥1,162 million (cash used of ¥1,237 million in the same period of the previous fiscal year).

The cash outflow was primarily attributable to a decrease in cash for the purchase of property, plant and equipment of ¥869 million and acquisition of right-of-use assets of ¥294 million.

(Cash flows from financing activities)

Net cash used in financing activities was ¥6,625 million (cash used of ¥2,929 million in the same period of the previous fiscal year).

The results largely reflected a decrease in cash due to payments for acquisition of interests in subsidiaries from non-controlling interests of $\pm 2,388$ million, purchase of treasury shares of $\pm 1,021$ million, dividends paid of $\pm 1,516$ million, and dividends paid to non-controlling interests of $\pm 1,154$ million.

(3) Explanation of consolidated financial results forecasts and other forward-looking statements

Our consolidated financial results forecasts for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026 have been revised based on our financial results for the six months ended September 30, 2025. For details, please reference our "Notice of Revisions to Financial Results forecasts and Dividend Forecasts."

Furthermore, regarding our dividend forecast for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026, based on our fiscal year financial results forecasts, we have increased our fiscal year-end dividend forecast by \(\frac{\pmathbf{4}}{4}\) per share to \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{36}\) per share and revised our annual dividend forecast to \(\frac{\pmathbf{7}}{2}\) per share.

(This represents a \(\frac{4}{8}\)8 increase from annual dividend forecast of \(\frac{4}{6}\)4 per share announced on May 13, 2025.)
